

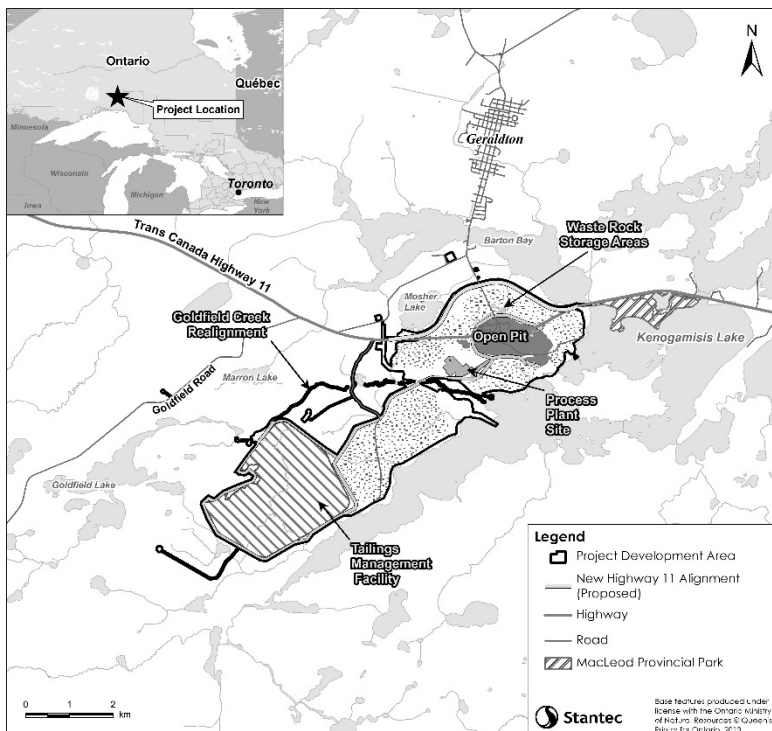
Mine Closure Plan Information Meetings

Greenstone Gold Mines GP Inc., Hardrock Project



Greenstone Gold Mines (GGM) is nearing the completion of the Environmental Impact Statement/Environmental Assessment (EIS/EA) process for the Hardrock Project. In preparation for filing a certified Mine Closure Plan for the project under the Ontario Mining Act early in 2019, following approval of the Provincial EA, GGM plans to hold information sharing meetings regarding the mine closure plan in October 2018.

The Hardrock Project involves the establishment, construction, operation, and decommissioning/closure of an open pit gold mine and ore processing facility, and ancillary activities. The Hardrock Gold Deposit is located approximately 275 kilometers northeast of Thunder Bay, Ontario. It is situated in the Ward of Geraldton, which is part of the amalgamated Municipality of Greenstone.



The draft mine closure plan has largely been based on the Conceptual Closure Plan that formed part of the Final Environmental Impact Statement/Environmental Assessment application. As required by section 141 of the *Ontario Mining Act*, public information meetings will be held in the communities of Geraldton and Longlac on October 17, 2018 to provide a summary of the mine closure plan. Additional meetings are being scheduled with interested Aboriginal communities.

A draft copy of the draft mine closure plan will be available for public review and comment from October 17th to November 17th, 2018. You may review the draft closure plan during normal business hours at the GGM Community Relations office at 404 Main Street in Geraldton.
