# 2nd Annual Premier Gold Mines Community BBQ

Geraldton, August 7, 2014

Premier Gold Mines hosted its Second Annual Community BBQ event welcoming more than 300 people at the Hardrock Road operations site just south of Geraldton. The Hardrock Road operations site has seen several expansions over the past 8 months with the most recent being the construction of the Exploration Workshop which is a milestone in the development of future operations.

a positive impact on the communities. Premier continues to host open houses in the Greenstone area, and has committed to ensuring all stakeholders are kept up to date on project developments. The Feasibility Study is expected to be completed by the end of the first quarter of 2015 and will provide Premier Gold with the necessary information to make a decision on the future of the project.
