



Greenstone Gold Mines L.P. (GGM) is a 50/50 joint venture partnership between Centerra Gold Inc. and Premier Gold Mines Ltd. formed for the purpose of the joint ownership and development of the Greenstone Gold Property including the Hardrock Gold Project located on a historical mine site in the Geraldton-Beardmore Greenstone belt in Ontario. The Hardrock Project is managed directly by a dynamic and experienced Owner's team, with an estimated \$1.2 Billion investment over the four-year engineering, procurement and construction phase, with an estimated 15-year operating life.

- Engage community leadership and representatives, solicit on-going input and feedback, and collaborate on human resources, training, business, and other matters consistent with the agreements.
- Implement commitments, and ensure GGM is in compliance with its requirements
- Support the collaborative design and active participation in the Long Temp Relationship Agreement Implementation Committee(s)
